PERSECUTIONS IN PERSIA

### Great Opposition is Aroused Against the Pentecostal Awakening of

the People.

The work here has begun in the Apostolic way. Hallelujah! During two weeks street meetings in a little town a great number were saved of whom thirty-five received the baptism in the Holy Ghost, speaking powerfully in other languages, some of which were understood well. Being the first Pentecostal Revival in the history of Persia, the country has been stirred up against this work until the Russian 31 Quinsan Road, Shanghai, China.
