The Secret of a Life of God-Guaranteed Prosperity

HERE is a prosperity which is not blessed, that comes not from above but from beneath. This prosperity of the wicked is often a sore perplexity to the servants of God. Many besides the Psalmist have been tempted to ask, "Is there knowledge in the Most High?" While Satan remains the god of this world this source of perplexity will continue to those who do not enter the sanctuary and consider the latter end of the worldling.

But thank God there is a true prosperity which comes from Him and leads towards Him. Not only is it consistent with perfect integrity and uncompromising holiness of heart and life, but it cannot be attained without them. This divine prosperity is God's purpose for every believer in all that he undertakes in things temporal and in things spiritual. According to the first Psalm it is God's will for each child of His that "whatsoever he doeth shall prosper." Shall we not each ask, "Is this blessed prosperity my experience? If not, what is the reason?"

"Blessed is the man that walketh not in the counsel of the ungodly." Notice it does not say he walks not in wicked counsel, for a man of God would not do that. It says, "He walks not in the counsel of the wicked." Now the wicked have often much worldly wisdom, and the child of God should be on his guard against their counsel. The Word of God will make him wiser than all such counsellors. And the wise child of God will carefully ascertain the standpoint of a fellow-believer, for Satan frequently makes handles of the people of God, as in Peter's case. Little did the astonish-ed Peter know whence his exhortation to the Lord to pity Himself came. "Get thee behind Me, Satan" showed that the Lord had traced this counsel to its true source. Whenever the supposed interests of self, or family, or country, or even of church or mission come first, we should beware.

"Nor standeth in the way of sinners." The way of the sinner no more suits a

true believer than the way of the believer suits the sinner. As a witness for his Master in the hope of saving the lost, he may go to them; but he will not, like Lot, set his tent towards Sodom. How many parents who have fluttered moth-like near the flame have seen their children destroyed by it, while they themselves have not escaped unscathed! And how many churches and institutions in the attempt to attract the unconverted by worldly inducements and amusements have themselves forfeited the blessing of God, and have so lost spiritual power

that those whom they have attracted have been nothing benefited! Instead of seeing the dead quickened, a state of death has crept over themselves. Sufficent attraction for the church lies in Christ Himself, for He said, "I, if I be lifted up, will draw all men unto Me." Our Master was ever "separate from sinners," and the Holy Spirit clearly says, "What fellowship hath righteousness with unrighteousness, and what communion hath light with dark-

"Nor sitteth in the seat of the scornful." The seat of the scornful is one of the special dangers of this age. Pride, presumption, and scorn are closely linked together. This spirit often shows itself today in the form of irreverent criticism; those who are least qualified for it are found sitting in the seat of judgment, rather than taking the place of the inquirer and the learner. The Bereans of old did not scornfully reject the teachings of Paul that seemed strange to them, but searched the Scriptures daily to see whether these things were so. In this day, indeed, the Scriptures them-selves are called in question, and the very foundations of Christian faith are abandoned by men who would fain be looked upon as the apostles of modern thought!

"But his delight is in the law of the Lord." The unregenerate cannot do this. They may admire the Bible and be loud in its praises—for it is the most wonderful Book in the world-but when they become converted they discover they have a new Bible.

It is not difficult to discover what a man delights in. "Out of the abundance of the heart the mouth speaketh." The mother delights to speak of her babe, the politician loves to talk of politics, the scientific man of his favorite science, and the athlete of his sport. In the same way the earnest, happy Christian will naturally and spontaneously speak often of the Word of God in which he

The words, "the law of the Lord,"

which we understand to mean the whole Word of God, are very suggestive. They indicate that the Bible is intended to teach us what God would have us to do. We should not merely seek for the promises and try to get all we can from God. It is recorded of Ezra that he prepared his heart to seek the law of the Lord in order that he might do it, and teach in Israel its statutes and judgments; as a result the hand of God was upon him for good.

"And in His law doth he meditate day and night." Not only will the Bible become a pattern for the life of the blessed man, but still more it will reveal what God Himself is and does. The man of God will also delight to trace God in the Word as the great Worker, and rejoice in the privilege of being a fellow-worker with Him. The fellow-workers may all pass away, but what has been wrought in God will abide, and whatever is incomplete the Great Worker will bring to completion.

In this Psalm is one of the most remarkable and inclusive promises of the Scriptures. If we could offer to the ungodly a worldly plan which would ensure their prospering in all they undertake, how eag-erly they would follow it! And yet when God reveals so effectual a plan to His people, how few avail themselves of it! Many fail on the negative side and do not come clearly out of the world. Many others fail on the positive side and allow other duties and indulgences to take the time that should be given to the Word of God. To some it is not at all easy to secure time for the morning watch; however, nothing can make up for the loss of it. Let us consider all the blessings that God promises here:

Stability. "He shall be like a tree" (not a mere annual) of steady, progressive growth and increasing fruitfulness.

Independent supplies. "Planted by the rivers of water." The ordinary supplies of rain and dew may fail, but his deep and hidden sources cannot.

Seasonable fruitfulness. "That

bringeth forth his fruit in his season." How beautiful! The figure is not that of water flowing through a channel; but of fruit, the very outcome of our own transformed life—a life of union with Christ. It is so gracious of God not to work through us in a mere mechanical way, but to make us branches of the true Vine, the very organ by which His fruit is produced.

There is a fundamental difference between fruit and work. Work is the outcome of effort; fruit of life. A bad man may do good work, but a bad tree cannot bear good fruit. The result of work is not reproductive, but fruit has its seed in itself. And further, the Scriptures do not speak of the fruits of the Spirit in the plural, as though we might take our choice among the graces named. It speaks of fruit in the singular—a rich cluster composed of love, joy, peace, long-suffering, etc. How blessed to bring forth such fruit in its season.

Continuous vigor. "His leaf also shall not wither." In our climate many trees are able to maintain their life through the winter, but unable to retain their leaves. The hardy evergreen, however, not only lives but maintains its leaf—and all the more conspicuously because of the naked branches around. The life within is too strong to fear the shortened day, the cold blast, or the falling snow. So with the man of God whose life is maintained by communion, adversity only brings out the strength and reality of

the life within.

The leaf of the tree is no mere adornment. If the root suggests receptive power, the leaves no less remind us of the grace of giving and of purifying. The thin, stimulating sap that comes from the root could not of itself build up the tree. Through the leaves it breathes in carbon from the atmosphere. The timiest rootlets are as much nourished by the leaves as the latter are fed by

by the leaves as the latter are fed by the roots. Keep a tree despoiled of its leaves and it will surely die.

Uniform prosperity. "And whatsoever he doeth shall prosper." Could any promise go beyond this? It is the privilege of the child of God to see His hand in all circumstances, and to serve God in all his activities. And the servant of God may count on a sufficiency from God for all manner of need.

This prosperity will not always be apparent, except to the eye of faith. Doubtless the legions of hell rejoiced when they saw the Lord of Glory nailed to the accursed tree, yet we know that never was our blessed Lord more prospered than when He offered Himself as our atoning Sacrifice. The path of real prosperity will often lie through deepest suffering, but followers of Christ may well be content with the path He trod.

A Word for the New Year

"Ever a lover!" Do you remember this word in Scripture? You will find it in 1 Kings 5:1. It is spoken of one who was "ever a lover" of David.

David was a great lover too. It is recorded that the love between him and his friend Jonathan was "passing the love of women."

Our greater David—David's greater Son—is "ever a lover." His is a personal love. Said Paul, "He loved me and gave Himself for me." And the Word says, "He gave Himself . . . for all." 1 Tim. 2:6. He did not leave you out.

David did not forget his friendship with Jonathan. After Jonathan's death he desired to show "the kindness of Jehovah" to one of the seed of Jonathan. He was told of one of his seed—one who would not grace the royal court at all. Why, he was lame on both feet! Surely the king did not want anyone like that around him! But in his great love David insisted that Mephibosheth—despite his two lame feet—should come and live with him and share with him at his own bountiful table.

The Lord made a confidential friend of Abraham. Genesis 18. And His love and friendship with Abraham is extended to all his seed. The word declares, "If ye be Christ's then are ye Abraham's seed."

Do you think the Lord loved His friend Abraham less than David loved his friend Jonathan? Do you think He loves Abraham's seed less than David loved the seed of Jonathan? Will He be any less practical in showing "the kindness of Jehovah" to you—one of Abraham's seed? You may object, "But I am so poor, so needy, one so foolish, so weak, so base." Then you are just the kind He loves to help. When He makes a feast He delights to call the halt -the lame on both feet-the maimed, the blind. He brings such into His banqueting house, and His banner over them is love. And He bids them, "Eat, O friends (I call you . . . friends. John 15:15.) drink, yea, drink abundantly, O beloved." Believe what our bountiful Lover says, "All things are yours." And He bids you to pass on the invitation to others, to echo the words of the prophet, "Ho, every one that thirsteth, come." You can say to them as He says to you, "Let your soul delight in fatness." The finest of the wheat and honey out of the Rock!

Our Lover tells us in 1 Corinthians 12 of nine lovely New Year gifts He has for us. One of them is called "the gift of tongues," a secret lover language which no man understandeth, but which our Lover understands perfectly, and one He encourages all His lovers to constantly use in His presence.

Our Lover woos us with these words, "Even as the Father hath loved me, I also have loved you: abide ye in my love." John 15:9, R. V. Even as! Can you grasp it? Then He says to us, "This is My commandment, that ye love one another even as I have loved you." John 15:12, R. V. Even as! He further says to us, "If ye love me, ye will keep my commandments." John 14:15, R. V. Our Lover will enable us. Says Paul, "I can do all things through Christ who enableth me." Phil. 4:13 literal Greek.

Tradition tells us that the apostle John in his old age would ask the young men to carry him to the assembly, and though too feeble to teach he would always give them the same word of exhortation, "Little children, love one another." When asked why he always said the same thing, he said, "Because it is the Lord's command, and if that be done, enough is done."

It was John who said, "His commandments are not grievous," and he summarizes them: They are just to trust and to love—"that we should believe on the name of his Son Jesus Christ, and love one another."

Our Lover Lord solemnly warns us of the last day peril, "Because iniquity shall abound, the love of the many shall wax

cold." Are you one of the many? Has your love waxed cold? He said to those of the church of Ephesus, "You no longer love Me as you did at first. Be mindful therefore, of the height from which you have fallen. Repent at once, and act as you did at first, or else I will surely come and remove your lampstand out of its place—unless you repent." Rev. 2:4, 5. (Weymouth's translation). We are bidden, "Keep yourselves in the love of God." Jude 21.

The Prayer Life

"First of all . . . prayers." 1 Tim. 2:1. Said a missionary to Andrew Murray, "But it is really impossible to find time to pray as we wish to."

That godly man replied, "What our hearts consider of first importance in a day we will soon succeed in finding time for."

He further said, "The ministry of intercession is the most important part of our life work. We in the ministry think that our work of preaching and visiting is our real duty, and that prayer is a subordinate means to do this work successfully. Should not we regard the ministry of intercession as the chief thing-getting the blessing and power of God for the lost entrusted to us?

"It was when the one at midnight, in answer to his prayer, had received from Another as much as he needed, that he could supply his hungry friend. It was the intercession, going out and importuning, that was the difficult work. Returning home with his rich supply to impart was easy, joyful work. This is Christ's divine order for all your work. First come, in utter poverty, every day, and get from God the blessing in intercession, and then go rejoicingly to impart it."

The Wonderful Word A Sermon in Miniature

First Things First

1. "First" the kingdom: "Seek ye first the kingdom of God . . . and all these things shall be added unto you." Matt. 6:33. Many put the "all things" first, and lose them and the kingdom too. Seek first a place in the kingdom, and the righteousness the King gives. Then always seek first the interests of the kingdom and the King.

2. "First" the inward c'ansing. "Cleanse first that which is within . . . that the outside . . . may be clean also." Matt. 23:26. God begins inside with the heart, not with the outside clothing first. When the heart is cleansed and Christ indwells, the immodest and the vain in the outward will soon be seen no

longer.
3. "First" Christ and His claims. Some said to Him, "Lord, suffer me first . . ." Luke 9:59-61. "Me first" is not God's order. He purposes that in all things Christ shall have the pre-eminence-first place in the life. Say to Him, "Blessed Master, I put Thee first. Thy will, not mine, be done."

4. "First" your love, then your service. The Master said, "I know thy works." "Thou hast left thy first love." Rev. 2:2, 4. It is possible for us to get so absorbed in service that we lose our fervent love for the Person of Christ. But love must be first and foremost. "By love serve." The lovers of the Lamb become His most effective and efficient servants.

5. "First" " . . . prayers." 1 Tim. 2:1. Said the apostles, "We will give ourselves continually to prayer and to the ministry of the Word." Communion with the Lord first, then ministry through His power. This was the order in the life of the Master, and must be the order in the life of the servant also.

6. "First" show piety at home. "Let them learn first to show piety (margin, "kindness")

at home." 1 Tim. 5:4. It is in the home first that we are to show forth the kindness of the Christ who indwells us. A loving, patient life in the home will bring blessing to every inmate. In the home where there is loving unity the Lord will ever command

His blessing. Psalm 133.

7. "First" yourself as a pattern. Said Paul, "In me first . . . for a pattern." When others see in us the pattern of what our lovely Christ is, that through the continuous vision of Him we are being transformed into His likeness, it will be the strongest "Christian Evidence" to them of the reality of Christ and His Word.

The Sunday School Tesson

The Miraculous Crossing of Jordan

Lesson for January 16. Lesson Text— Joshua 3 and 4.

Purpose of the Miracle. 4:24. "That all of the people of the earth might know the hand of the Lord that it is mighty; that ye might fear the Lord your God forever."

The Book of Joshua is the "Book of Acts of the Old Testament." In the New Testament chronicle Luke records the conquest of the young Church of Christ. The last verse in Mark's Gospel is a Holy Ghost summary of the entire Book of Acts. "And

of the entire Book of Acts. "And they went forth and preached, the Lord working with them, and confirming the word with the signs following." The preached Word, the personal Presence of Christ, the power of the Spirit performing miracles, this was the secret of the conquests of the New Testament Church. Likewise, obedience to the proclaimed Word, the Presence of God (as typified by the Ark of the Covenant) and the performance of miracles, constitute the secret of Israel's conquest of Canaan.

God's Hallmark. Miracles are not always from a divine source. None the less miracles are one of the signs of God's presence and power. Aaron proved his divine credentials to Pharaoh by having his rod turn into a serpent. But the Egyptian sorcerers, Satanically endowed, duplicated the miracle-their rods turned into serpents. However, God demonstrated His supreme power over that of Satan by causing Aaron's serpent to swallow the Egyptian serpents. Ex. 7:10-12. In the last days, just before the revelation of Antichrist, false cults and false religions abound "with all power and signs and lying wonders." The miraculous gifts of the Holy

Spirit, God's healing power, are counterfeited by some of Satan's "lying wonders." 2 Thess. 2:8-12. How can the unskilled Christian differentiate between the genuine-the divine, and the counterfeit-the Satanic? Look for the Ark! Look for the Presence of Christ! Thus in today's lesson the Ark led the procession in the miraculous crossing. The Ark was given the place of prominence. Have nothing to do with any movement, any religion, which does not place the true Ark, Jesus Christ, at the head, which does not make Him Lord of all. Any teaching, any religious group under whatever name it functions, and their names today are legion, which does not make Christ first-supreme-owning Him as Lord of all, leave alone (cf. 1 John 4:1-3)! "If He is not 'Lord of all,' He is not Lord at all." The Acid Test. When Peter and the disciples saw Jesus walking on the water (Matt. 14:25-32), Peter said, "Lord, if it be thou, bid me come to thee on the water." The writer recently dealt with a very modern minded young person who insisted that all of the miraculous in all religions was of God, whether demonstrated by a Spirit-filled child of God, or by a Hindoo Yogi. Likewise she contended that all faith has a divine source, whether it was faith in Eddyism, Spiritism, or in the genuine gospel. She thereupon used Peter's experience as above mentioned in walking on the water, and declared that anyone,

today-having faith-regardless of the source of that faith, could do likewise! We pointed out to her that Peter only ventured out after he made sure the Ark was ahead! Peter said "Lord, if it be thou." Then we had the grand opportunity of pointing out to this young person that this must be the acid test of every religious experience. (1) It must originate in Christ. (2) The enabling command must come from Christ. (3) The objective, the destination-as was Peter's-must be into the outstretched hands of Christ. Let us have nothing to do with any religious experience or leader which cannot measure up to this standard.

Keeping the Ark in View. We repeat—The Ark was a type of Christ. Joshua 3:4 stipulated that a space of almost a mile be main-

tained between the Ark in the vanguard of the procession and the first of the people. The purpose here was to make the Ark (Christ) visible to all, not only to those nearest Him but also to those far in the rear. For this is the secret of progress in the Christian life. Read Heb. 12:1, 2, "Looking unto Jesus the author and the finisher of our faith." The tense here implies-we must keep our eyes continually fixed on Jesus. The famous tight-rope walker, Blondin, who thrice crossed Niagara Falls, making one perilous journey with a man on his shoulders, was once asked the secret of his being able to maintain his equilibrium under such stress. He replied "When I place my foot on the taut wire to take the first step, I fix my gaze on some immovable object on the opposite shore and never remove my gaze from it all the while I am walking. This gives me a sense of

balance." Is not this the secret of maintaining spiritual, Christian equilibrium? To fix our eyes on Jesus when we take the first step of our Christian life and then never to take our gaze away from Him? Many have failed because they took their eyes off Him (the true Ark), and looked instead to some great leader, some teacher, some friend, who, alas! had feet of clay like themselves. Then when their idol fell, their faith failed. But Jesus never fails. He is not only the Author-the Beginner of our faith, He is also its

The Way of Escape. In 1 Cor. 10:11 Paul states that all of Israel's experiences happened unto them as examples for us "upon whom the ends of the age have come." In verse 13 he proceeds to declare that in every test which the Christian is called to endure, "God will provide a way of escape." God has not promised His children freedom from testings in the spirit, soul, or body, but He has promised them a way of escape. Israel was confronted with the test of crossing Jordan. She had no army engineers who could build her a pontoon bridge over which every man, woman, child and beast could safely cross. But

she had something better! God marshaled the battalions of heaven and His unseen angels held back the flow of Jordan, "the Descender," in its mightiest flood stage so that "all the Israelites passed over on dry ground" (3:17). On one occasion, when the African missionary, Dan Crawford, came to a stream in the heart of Africa he discovered that a bridge upon which he and his bearers had hoped to cross, had been swept away by a tropical storm. It was imperative that Crawford cross that stream immediately, but the bridge was gone. Crawford prayed. A lightning bolt struck a huge tree standing at the river's brink, felling it neatly across the raging current and making a perfect natural bridge for Crawford and his men. "The Royal Engineers of Heaven," wrote Crawford, "laid us a bridge in five seconds' time." God will always provide a way of escape for His trusting people who keep their eyes on "The Ark." Notice the golden text of the lesson. "When thou passest through the waters I will be with thee." God never promised His people immunity from the waters of trouble and affliction, but He has promised to "waterproof" them with His presence-"I will be with thee." "I will be with him in trouble. I will deliver him." Psalm 91:9. In South America there lives a species of land spider which can survive the experience of being submerged in water because the Lord has created within it the ability to form an air bubble all around itself upon which it floats in the water. If God has so endowed a little insect, can He not also enable His children to be so enveloped by Himself, so to "dwell in God" that they will pass through all

of life's experiences "more than conquerors"?

The Memorial. 4:20-24. How prone we are to forget God's goodness! The Psalmist had to keep exhorting his soul, "Bless the Lord, O my soul and forget not all His benefits." Peter told the Christians that we need to stir up our pure minds by way of remembrance. Psalm 103:1, 2; 2 Peter 3:1. Twelve men, one representing each Tribe of Israel, each took a stone from the river bed of Jordan and when they had reached its far side they erected with the stones a memorial to God's mighty miracle in enabling them all to cross Jordan dry-shod. This memorial was to be an aid in informing their children, the next generation, of God's "old time pow-er." In our own Pentecostal movement we have come to the second generation. Many of our young people were born into Pentecostal homes. It is possible to be Pentecostal by environment, by birth, and yet not by conviction. When this is the case it makes for lightness and superficiality. The depth of a personal and powerful spiritual experience is apt to be lacking. Such can use Pentecostal phraseology but be lacking in Pentecostal power. Such are prone to ask, "What mean these stones?" "What is Pentecost?" "What do the older folk mean by 'the early days of Pentecost'? by 'the old-time pow-May the Lord help us not to forget. May living memorials be erected and enshrined in all our hearts. We need have no repinings for the "early days," "the good old days," if we will but remember that God is "the Great I Am"-not, "the Great I Was." What He did in the past, He can and will do again, if His people will meet the condition. What is the condition? Read Joshua 3:5: "Sanctify yourselves, for tomorrow the Lord will do wonders among you." Let us not dwell in God's yesterdays. We should not forget them, but let us make glad and willing preparation for God's "tomorrow." "Tomorrow, the Lord will do wonders among you." The God of Joshua, of the yesterday, is our God, the Great I Am"-"Jesus Christ, the same, yesterday and today and forever." Joshua's people made an inward spiritual preparation. First, they "sanctified themselves." Consequently the outward demonstration of God's power followed. Are our children asking "What mean these stones?" Let us all as parents and children sanctify ourselves, and glad "tomorrows" fraught with Pentecostal power will dawn for us all.-Harry Steil.

MODERN WARFARE

Aerial bombs of a destructive power undreamed of in the Great War have been used in aerial attacks upon Chinese cities, according to reports which have reached the Commonwealth Government. These bombs, said to weigh 900 pounds, could, in a congested area, kill up to a thousand people instantly. Surely these are inventions "which destroy the earth." Rev. 11:18.

THE CITY OF THE FUTURE

"The omission of Jerusalem from the new Jewish state has caused great concern among the Jews," observes Revelation. "Resentment is aroused by the common reference to Tel Aviv as the city of the present, Haifa as the city of the future and Jerusalem as the city of the past. Several hundred thousand copies of a new book advertising Jerusalem as a city of the future are being prepared and distributed throughtout the world. The title of the work is 'The Book of the New Jerusalem.'"

FOLLOWING JOSEPH'S FORESIGHT

Said President Roosevelt: "The new national farm act should . . . provide for storage of reserve food supplies in an ever-normal granary; so that when severe and widespread drought occurs, consumers will be assured of more adequate supplies, with less drastic increases in price than would otherwise be the case."

Comments *Philadelphia Record*: "There is nothing really new or revolutionary about the proposal. Joseph used it in ancient Egypt and it worked in China for centuries."

REVENUE IN PALESTINE

We learn from the Alliance Weekly, that "two thirds of the revenue of the Palestine Government comes from Jews. Out of this income the government spends more than \$4,000,000 a year for Arab education and only \$300,000 for Jewish education, although the Jews compose one-third of the population of the country and pay two-thirds of the taxes." A similar proportion of the government budget for public health went for work among the Arabs. "Palestine," it adds, "because of the infusion of Jewish blood, has made more rapid progress than any other country in the world."

DRUGS

A well-known daily reports that Chinese territories under Japanese control are being demoralized by the development of the drug traffic on a scale never previously equaled. This fact was reported by a League of Nations committee. "Factories have been set up and are turning out heroin in quantities many times in excess of the whole world's legitimate demands. In one Sino-Japanese city alonethat of Harbin-50,000 drug addicts are said by a credible witness to visit the heroin dens daily. There has also begun an export trade to Europe, America, and Northern Africa to an extent which is believed to make the Far East the source of nearly 90 per cent of all the illicit heroin traffic in the world."

"MUCH DARKNESS THERE" John L. Franklin, Guatemala

"Then spake Jesus to them saying, I am the light of the world. He that followeth me shall not walk in darkness, but shall have the light of life."

I recall a conversation I had recently with a man who had just believed on the Lord the night before. He had come to one of our mission stations from his home some miles away. "Now, I am going back to my home," said he, "pray for me, because I shall be the only Christian in my town—the only one among five thousand, and there is much darkness there." As I stood there I was greatly stirred at heart because of those words of his—"There is much darkness there." Then I thought of the many Christian churches and friends and influences in the homeland, for there you have much light, but here we have much darkness. That is why it is difficult for you who dwell in much light to feel how dense is the darkness on the foreign fields.

Well, I put my hand on his roughly-clad shoulder and looked into his face, and said, "Yes, Brother, you are going to a dark place, but you are a light now. Jesus has lighted you. You must return to your home and be a light, and though you be just a little light, remember that light shines in darkness, and can be seen a long way. Jesus says, 'Ye are the light of the world: let your light so shine before men that they may see your good works and glorify your Father which is in heaven.'" So he went—to be a witness of the Light. May God bless him, and may many souls come to Jesus through him!

Also in this same mission station a man and his wife came to hear the gospel (it was their first time to hear it) and were saved. Now they have gone back to their town; and we have a light there shining for Jesus. Here we see the blessing of letting our light shine. We light other lights, and they go and light others. If each one of us should let our light shine as it ought to shine it would not be long until the whole world would be lighted.

Saved in a Hospital

Once we visited a hospital in a town where we have a mission station, and there we talked with a young man who immediately surrendered to the Lord. Several months passed by and we heard no more of him. One day we went to another town to try to open up a new mission station. We had been burdened for this place for some time and wondered how it could be opened to the gospel. We were not long in hearing that there was a man there who had recently become a Christian, and that since accepting Christ as his Saviour, a great change had taken place in his life. We learned that it was the same

young man who was saved in the hospital in the other town.

He had gone there on some business, but being a great drunkard, he was seized with delirium tremens, got into trouble and was thrown into jail. From there he was taken to the hospital, where we met him and he gave his heart to the Lord. Returning to his home a new creature, there amid the darkness he let his light shine. Many heard about the change that had been wrought in his life, so when we started our meeting there, we had to secure the largest building in town, as so many wanted to hear and inquire about "the Way."

A few days went by without our seeing any results. Then one night, before a crowd

of three hundred people, a woman got up and said, "I accept the Lord Jesus Christ as my only and sufficient Saviour!" There was a great stir, and the people who had been standing in the rear of the building hastened forward to see such a person. They had never heard of such a thing before. They gazed with mixed wonder and curiosity upon a woman who would dare to confess the Lord Jesus as her Saviour.

"I Accept the Lord"

In this same town a man lay dying. He had heard the gospel in our meetings there, so we went to see him. We found him gasping for breath. "I believe the message you have been bringing," he said; "you have been telling the truth. I accept it; in my heart I accept the Lord Jesus as my Saviour." We prayed for his healing, also, and though he is an old man, he may yet live. Others are turning to the Lord there, and a multitude are under conviction. We believe it is largely because one young man let his light shine there. The gospel is growing in favor before the whole city; and with your helping us in prayer we may have a great work there, and have many saved among its nine thousand inhabitants.

Workers Needed

We began to pray that God would raise up a worker for this place, and at last a young married man in a nearby village felt God was leading him to this field of labor. He is giving up all to go. We have promised him \$5.00 a month for a few months to help him get started. We are looking to the Lord to supply the money.

We have another worker, earnest and zealous, and consecrated to the Lord. He is longing to go to a certain place and begin a work, but can scarcely do anything for the lack of funds. We went with him on a visit to these towns and preached a couple of nights to crowds of people who stood out on the wet ground and in the mud to hear for the first time the glorious gospel. We feel the burden of having workers in every

city, town, and village in this country. The success of any missionary work depends upon consecrated native workers. A native church must be built and that church must soon come to be self-supporting, and somewhat independent of the missionary, but that will take much time and labor. We are doing everything possible toward the training of native workers. The Bible school in El Salvador is going forward in a great way. We have many men desiring to dedicate their lives to Christian service and go to Bible school. Any offering that you may send designated for this purpose will be an investment which will bear much fruit in the salvation of souls. Then, too, we have a few workers who

Brother and Sister Franklin add an interesting paragraph referring to one of the cases they mentioned in the first part of their letter:

Just in Time

"Since writing this letter and telling about the old man who accepted the Lord as his Saviour, we have returned to this city and there found him raised from his bed and on the road to recovery. He attributed his healing to our prayers, and then told his story. He said the first he heard of the gospel was when a certain woman of a nearby town was threatened with being stoned because she had become a believer, and he, being a commander in the army, was sent with some police to protect her. At that time, however, it did not enter his mind that the gospel was the power of God unto salvation.

"As he lay on his bed of sickness he thought he was going to die and began to seek to make peace with God, but could not. He said he could find no rest for his mind or heart. Finally in a semi-conscious condition of mind, when he seemed to be slipping from this world to meet his God unsaved and without hope, he saw a little round white disk of light that commenced to grow larger and larger, but in a few moments it began to diminish, becoming very small until it finally disappeared altogether-and there was darkness!

"It was just at this time, in the divine providence of God, that we entered the room and found him. We scarcely thought it profitable to speak to him, seeing he was

so nearly unconscious and gasping for breath, but we commenced talking to him in a simple way about salvation. He told us afterward that in the moment we began to talk to him and pray for him, he saw a light, and that light began to grow and grow until it had banished every shadow. He said, 'And there was no more darkness. Now I am glad,' he continued, 'that the missionary has come; for he has made the way of salvation plain to me.' May God have the glory!"

In another letter Brother and Sister Franklin write: "We had another Confraternidad (Fellowship Meeting) at our new mission station just recently. It proved to be the best we have had yet. In spite of much sickness and death on this field at present, the six stations were all well represented. During this conference we held a baptismal service, and baptized thirty believers. They have all given full proof of their salvation, and are being received into the membership of the assembly.

"As the crowd was leaving we took a picture of some of them. The group on the trail shown in the accompanying picture were starting out on their long journey to their homes eighteen miles away.

"We have an account of eighty-nine souls saved the last two months, and eighty-eight in the six months previous. Praise the Lord!"

A DEAD MAN COMES BACK TO LIFE

Harry A. Miller of the African Inland Mission, writing under date of April 4, 1937, relates the following in the *Moody Monthly:*

"About three weeks ago a native man who had been suffering from tuberculosis for a number of years, died. For a long time he had been defiant toward the gospel, but had repented and accepted the Lord just a short time before his death. The relatives prepared for the burial, by washing the body, shaving the head, and digging the grave. (Africans customarily bury their dead in a sitting posture.) The body was so rigid that the natives were unable to bend the man's arms. Some of the Christians from Kasengu came to hold the service, and while they were praying the man came to life—which caused no small amount of excitement.

"The man said that he was on the way to heaven, when he came to a fork in the road and was met by a soldier, who asked him where he was going; and he replied that he was on his way to heaven. The soldier said, 'You can't go to heaven until you return and burn your Jok houses.' 'Jok' is the word for Satan, and the natives have many of these miniature houses in which some sort of an offering is given to appease the evil spirits. The man said to his relatives, 'Go burn my Jok houses.' They refused; and because he was so weak, he himself was unable to do it. But finally after many words he remarked that if it wasn't for his relatives he would be on his way to heaven. By and by the relatives complied with his request and burned his Jok houses. Then he said, 'Now I am ready to die, for I am going to heaven.' He lingered on until the last Sunday in March, about two weeks after the incident."

Are you ready to die, and are you bound for heaven? It is written, "Whosoever shall call upon the name of the Lord shall be saved." Rom. 10:13.
